



Edgartown Lighthouse Children's Memorial

Based on an idea created by Rick Harrington after his son's death, and with his involvement and support, the Martha's Vineyard Museum created a Lighthouse Children's Memorial in 2001 to memorialize children who have passed away too soon. The Memorial is placed at the base of the Edgartown Light, a beacon of safety and hope. Stones are placed twice yearly, in the late spring and in late summer. We hold an annual Ceremony of Remembrance, to honor all of the children, each year in September.
